The Clerk will report that it needs to be cleaned to MTCBC and ask for an update when the wall repair is due to be carried out by the landowner.</p> <p>Cllr Preston also stated that three residents in Garth Terrace have complained about a van parking on the junction and wanted to raise it with the Police this evening, but they are not in attendance again. They will be advised to report it to 101 and the Clerk will also contact the local Police Officer to make him aware.</p> <p>It was suggested that an events Committee be setup to plan the budget and activities for the forthcoming year. Cllr Brown expressed an interest in being part of the committee. It was agreed that the Clerk will send out an email asking for expressions of interest and potential dates to meet.</p>
